Volunteer forms are found in the student handbook package or speak with one of our dock workers.

## Upcoming General Fund Raisers

There are a couple of upcoming fund raisers taking place that require 100% participation from all band members. The Kiski Competition is in full swing and there is separate information in this newsletter and on the dock for volunteering for that. We will also be doing a Tag Day (August 23), Steeler ticket raffle as well as a gas card raffle in the very near future. The funds raised from these fund drives are designated for the general fund but really each individual band member benefits. This year the total cost per band member is approximately \$1,010 of which \$495 is from individual assessments and \$515 from the general fund per student. This will pay for Cruiser costs, hotel and food costs at Nationals and a whole lot more. A more detailed description can be found in the student handbook. Please support these fund raisers as they ultimately lower the individual assessments.
