## BOA Video and Still Photography Guidelines

### VIDEO RECORDING EQUIPMENT

VIDEO NEWS MEDIA passes will be issued by BOA to qualified news media. No video or audio recording devices are allowed into the stadium, including those with "band videographers." Credentialed television news crews and BOA-pre-approved professional filmmakers are the only exceptions.

### PHOTOGRAPHY

Use of cameras of any kind are NOT ALLOWED on the field (stadium floor) for any BOA vent, except for Jolesch Photography, the Official Photographer of BOA, and official news media with credentials. Please communicate this to your parent/booster group.

**New for 2008:** Stillcameras (digital or film, professional or otherwise) are allowed into the stadium and maybe used from stadium seating, but not on the field. Tripods or other similar equipment that may obstruct the view or path of travel of others in seating areas are not allowed. The issuance of a "Field Pass" or other non-media BOA Credential does not include the right to use a camera on the field. Pass holders must go into stadium spectator seating to use their camera.

**PLEASE CHECK THE SIGN UPS FOR:** HALUSKI MAKERS, Roasters, Crock pots, **Ice Keepers**- if you can bag some ice from our ice machine and take it home to store for the competition please sign up.

**COMPETITION COOKIES:** Each band member is responsible for donating 2 dozen cookies for the competition cookie sale. Please place your name on your cookies when you drop them off at the stadium Saturday morning at 8:00 AM as there will be a check off list. We would rather have the cookies but we will accept a donation of \$6/member if you choose not to bake cookies- this will avoid your account being assessed for the \$6. **COMPETITION STUFF:** To help make our new parents aware of what their families and friends might enjoy at the Competition here is a preview. We have a menu of food items and cookies by the dozen for sale. We also have tables set up where you can buy AIRGRAMS and CANDYGRAMS. Airgrams are written messages of 12 words or less that are read by the announcer in between band performances. These can be for your Kiski band member or perhaps a friend or relative from a visiting band. The cost is \$2. CandyGrams are much the same except for \$2 you can pick 2 candy items, wrap them in a decorated label that you write your own message on, and the treats get delivered to a band member of your choice at the end of the night. Boosters will be in and around the stadium selling 50/50 raffle tickets, and keep your eye out for coffee, cookie, and cinnamon roll sellers.
