IMPORTANT REMINDER!!! BANDNIGHT

is October 3rd this year. Each band member is responsible for bringing with them that evening fudge for the band boosters to sell. Your fudge is to be a 9x13 pan cut into 2"x2" squares and packaged as follows: 2 pieces each, in a sandwich baggie or plastic wrap with the type of fudge marked on the front of the bag (ex: chocolate, peanut butter, choc. with walnuts..). Please do not forget to label the type of fudge since we sometimes cannot easily identify the kind just by looking at it and those are usually the pieces that do not sell since we can't tell the customer the flavor. Lastly, place the sandwich baggies in a box marked with your name, grade and section on it. Please note that specialty flavors, like creamsicle fudge, are always a big hit.

If you are unable to bring fudge we ask that you give \$8 in an envelope with your name, grade and section on it. If necessary your student account will be assessed the \$8 if payment or fudge is not donated. This is one of the General Fund fundraisers along with the car cruise that is mandatory for the parents to participate in. These fundraisers are critical in reducing personal student assessments.

The fudge or money is to be brought with you to Vandergrift Elementary on the 3rd and will be collected by band boosters set up in the school's side parking lot. It is important that your name, grade and section are written on the box of fudge or your envelope because band volunteers will be marking the band roster as items are collected. Student Pickup procedure after events.

If you are planning on taking your student home with you after an event the following procedures must be followed. For everyone's protection, there are no exceptions.

1. The student must give a permission note signed by the parent or guardian to the bus captain when entering the bus. The note must state the person taking them home. They are not permitted to ride with a boyfriend/girlfriend. Authorized adults only.
2. The student must return to the bus with the rest of the band at the end of the event and the person taking them home must sign the student out there with the bus captain. Students are not permitted to leave early at a home football game unless permission is given by the Director. Parents/Guardians please be prompt picking up your student after all band events. Home Football games students are dismissed from the Jackson Street gate after the game around 10 PM. Chaperones/Directors will not leave students behind or waiting alone. Your consideration and cooperation is greatly appreciated.
