



BIG "K" CRUISE-IN High School & College Student Division Rules

On October 3, 2010 Kiski Area Instrumental Boosters will be holding our 6th annual **Big K Cruise-In** at the Kiski Area High School from 11AM to 4PM. KAIB is the support organization for the Kiski Area Instrumental program which supports the Kiski Area Marching Band. This year a portion of the proceeds will be donated to the local Kiski Valley Food Banks. There will be a \$5.00 donation for all vehicles to be entered and shown in the cruise.

Our cruise is unique because we have incorporated a high school and college student division open to all students (under age 25) regardless of what school district they attend. We will have two divisions: open street stock and open street rod. Both classes are open to all types of vehicles. There will be a first through sixth place awarded in each division.

Rules are as follows:

1. Students must have an active high school identification or show proof that you are an active high school or college student.
2. Must have a valid PA operators license
3. Must have current liability insurance card in the vehicle.
4. Vehicle can only be registered to immediate family member (parents, grandparents, or a sibling) or to the student.
5. Vehicle must be driven onto school grounds by the student and is only to be exhibited by that student.
6. All vehicles must have an entry form on the dash area visible to judges.

Judging will be done by a committee chosen by KAIB and will start at 1:30PM. All students must present their vehicle to the judges when they are being judged. Vehicles will be graded on the following seven fields:

- Overall appearance
- Body condition (rust, panel damage)
- Under hood appearance (dirt, oil, etc.)
- Paint condition (waxed or dull)
- Wheels/tires (condition and appearance)
- Upholstery and interior condition
- Presentation by exhibitor (knowledge about vehicle)

Points will be given for each judged section and highest total points are trophy winners. Student participants will also be eligible for random drawn door prizes that will be drawn on the ticket you receive upon entering your vehicle. Please keep this ticket all day for eligibility.

We hope this will be a fun show and a learning experience for all students. Remember you will be on Kiski school grounds and all district rules apply. Reckless operation of vehicles and tire squealing will not be tolerated. Violators of any of these rules will be excused from school property. These types of behaviors could affect any further access to school property for future Cruise-In's at Kiski and other public schools. You are expected to clean up the area around your vehicle before you leave. Have fun and remember, the school board has approved this cruise-in and you will be proving to them and other districts that you are responsible young adults.
