Palombo

Tim from Palombos will be visiting on June 14 from 4:30 – 6:00. Palombos have been the Kiski Band's apparel supplier for years. He will be taking orders for Band Jackets, gloves and shoes. These are the only parts of the uniform that are the student's personal responsibility to obtain and are the only authorized apparel to be worn at performances. All remaining uniform items are provided by the school. It usually only takes about ½ hour to get everything taken care of and then you won't have to worry. See the

attached order form. This is the time to order (highly recommended) if you would like a band jacket for the upcoming season. These items can be expensed through your student account if you have a balance left after the seasons assessment is paid or you can turn in the expenses later in the year for reimbursement after you've had a chance to get more funds deposited in your student account from your fundraising. The expenses can only be submitted one time so it is best to wait and submit them after you have enough funds to cover the entire amount. Lessons and instruments can also be expensed from your student account. See the website for the required forms.

Student Account Information

Student accounts are established in your students name and then when you fundraise through the programs at KAIB or make contributions the funds are held in the student accounts. Student accounts can be used for yearly assessments, music lessons, instrument purchases, band apparel, and trips the band may make. As always, the student account cannot be accessed for any other reason until your yearly student assessment is paid so it makes sense to begin fundraising as soon as you can.
