Working at the concession stands at the home Steeler games for Aramark is a great way to earn money towards your student band account. Any friend or family member over 18 years old can also work and designate the funds to go into your account. As an example of how fast your account can accumulate is the fact that over \$12,000 student credit was earned through the Aramark program last year. Everybody who works the stand needs to have completed training by Aramark. The training only takes a little over 1 hour and is easy to complete. We are attempting to have the training done here at Kiski sometime in July or August but we need a total of 30 people for Aramark to come out. If you are interested in any way we suggest you complete the training. The training certificate is good for 3 years so if you are currently trained and would like to recertify this is a great opportunity. If you don't take the training at Kiski you can still go to the stadium and take it but that isn't as convenient. Marching Band Season is just around the corner. It is a good idea to fundraise year round to pay for the upcoming season or complete your student assessment for the 2009/2010 season.

The following are just a few easy options KAIB offers. Once you pay off your account for the year, the excess funds can be used to pay for instruments, band jackets, shoes, gloves, music lessons, guard supplies or student band trips. You pick and choose which fundraisers you are interested in participating for your convenience. Check the website often for additional fundraiser opportunities.

GIANT EAGLE CARDS -STUDENT CREDIT IS 4% OF THE CARD VALUE

You still get food perks and fuel perks and can purchase gift cards with the Giant Eagle cards.

IF YOU ARE GOING TO SPEND THE MONEY AT GIANT EAGLE OR GET GO ANYWAY, TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS OPPORTUNITY. IT COSTS NOTHING.

NO SELLING TO NEIGHBORS OR RELATIVES, BUT IF YOU CAN GET ONE OR TWO MORE FAMILY/FRIENDS TO PLAN AHEAD AND PURCHASE THE CARDS ALONG WITH YOURSELF, YOU CAN INCREASE THIS EASY FUNDRAISER!

For every \$100 purchased, \$4.00 goes to your student's account.

Spectator Trip to Bands of America Grand Nationals Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis, IN November 12-13, 2010

There will be an **optional** spectator trip for band members to watch the BOA National Championships at the Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis on November 12 and 13. Attending a Grand Nationals Championship is an invaluable experience. This trip will give our students the opportunity to watch and hear the best bands in the country, many of which we may compete against in the future. Charter buses will leave on Friday after school, November 12 and students will stay at a hotel Friday night. The band will attend the Grand National Semi-Finals and Finals performances on Saturday, then ride through the night and return home early Sunday morning. Students will need a small amount of cash for lunch or snacks at the stadium. Breakfast and dinner on Saturday will be provided. More specific details will follow at a later date.

Please discuss with your student as soon as possible as we need to make reservations very soon.

Here are the preliminary details:

- The trip will cost approximately **\$275** (this depends on how many attend).
- This is not included in the **\$395** assessment for this year's band season.
- Your \$395 season assessment must be **paid in full by October 15** to attend this trip.
Any previous balances must be paid as well (if applicable)
- The trip may be paid for from your students' account using the typical student account reimbursement guidelines.

Payment Schedules (These deadlines must be met for your child to participate on the trip)

- **August 30th - \$150 trip non-refundable deposit due**
- **October 15th - \$395 full season assessment due.**
- **October 30th - Approximate \$125 Nationals trip balance due.**

Please detach and sign the form below and return to the dock by the **July 12th** first full band practice. Please ask any questions you may have regarding the trip, fundraising or other issues to the boosters on the dock. They are there to assist in any of these matters.
