Help is Needed for Uniform and Luggage check-ins for nationals.

We are in need of volunteers to help this week to check in band members' uniforms and luggage for their trip to Grand Nationals. The uniform check-in for guard will be Tuesday Nov. 9 at 4:00 p.m.

Additionally, the band uniform check-in will be Wednesday after rehearsal. Luggage and medicine check in for the entire band will occur on Wednesday, Nov. 10 starting at 3:30 p.m. The vast majority of your students' luggage must be brought in and checked for any possible contraband. A parent or guardian must accompany you to the luggage and medicine check-in. Please make other arrangements if that isn't possible due to work schedules.

The student will be able to bring a "carry on" bag Thursday morning of report for Nationals as well as a small cooler that can hold their lunch as well as some drinks for the trip. A small amount of snacks can also be brought but we request you eat smart and pack smart. Whenever you come in for luggage check-in you will be required to see the medic privately to log in any medicine, both prescription and non-prescription, that you need for the trip. No medicines are permitted to be in the students' possession. The medic will be responsible to see your medicines are given properly. All medics for the trip are Registered Nurses with many years of experience and have a proven log in system to assure parents that medicines will be dispensed properly.

Luggage Loading Help Needed

We are in need of some strong backs to assist us to load all of the band luggage on Thursday morning. The guys going on the trip will be departed for Indianapolis by then so we need some other folks to pitch in. Please plan on staying when you drop off your band member on Thursday morning to help out.

CARPOOLING TO NATIONALS

If you are willing to drive anyone to nationals or if you want to carpool with others, we will post a list on the board at the dock. You will need to include you name and phone # and if you are willing to drive. The board may be inside in the hallway if the weather is too cold or windy.
