

KISKI BAND COMPETITION

Committee Descriptions

50 / 50 Raffle - Sells 50/50 raffle tickets at Competition; in spectator stands and various locations.

Airgrams - Table set-up under bleachers that sells Airgrams (messages that will be aired by the announcer prior to each band's performance)

Band Hosts - These individuals are assigned to a particular band(s). Their job is to greet the band upon their arrival; answer any questions (or find someone who knows). They will also escort the band to the field for their designated performance times.

Candygrams - Table set-up under bleachers that sells Candygrams (bags of candy that have messages written on them). They will be delivered to the band's designated area after the band has performed.

CLEAN-UP - obviousEVERYONE's HELP NEEDED !!!!! We clean-up before the competition, the night after and the day after.

Concessions - This committee sets up and operates the 2 concession areas that are open all evening. We need "cooks", runners, \$\$-takers, etc..... They are also responsible for the set-up and clean-up of the concession areas. Preparations start first thing Saturday morning.

KISKI Band & Staff Lunch - This committee is responsible for organizing, preparing, and serving lunch for the KISKI BAND during the afternoon practice.

Judges Luncheon - This committee is responsible for organizing, preparing, and serving a luncheon for the Judges. This will be in the "visiting locker room" at Davis Field. Responsibilities also include cleaning and setting up the locker room for our guests.

Committee Descriptions

Program Sales - This committee is responsible for selling the competition programs throughout the evening at various locations. They also keep the spectators from entering the stands during band performances.

Publicity - This committee is responsible for spreading the news about the competition. Posters will be made and displayed around the area.

Ticket Sales - This committee is responsible for admissions at the gate(s) at the competition. They also keep track of the number of sales and sort the tickets.

Field Management - They are responsible for directing the parking of the visiting buses and trucks. These individuals are responsible for getting the bands on and off the field at their designated times. They also make sure the field is lined before the competition begins and set the tables up as needed on the field and in the tower.

Cookie Packing and Sales - This committee collects the cookie donations from the band members as they report to the field for practice Saturday morning. They then pack the cookies in 1 dozen containers that will be sold at the competition by sellers that go through the stands to sell and from tables set up around the stadium.

Visiting Band Hospitality - These individuals are responsible for cleaning the bleacher area where the bands will sit after they perform (Visitors side) before and after the competition. They will hang signs for each band's designated area. They will also provide water for each band when they have re-entered the stadium to sit in their designated areas after they have performed.
