General Fund (operating expenses) goal of \$35,600. Student's assessment is reduced by \$115 from general fund. If you fund raise, you get a rebate which comes from general fund. Seniors get a bonus.

Kiski Competition is our biggest fund raiser. Last year we had 14 bands. This year we have 7 bands. Car Cruise is our next biggest fund raiser. Last year the Car Cruise funds were sent to a band affected by Katrina. This year, the funds will go to the general fund.

Reserves are set aside for future trips to help the student's assessment for a large trip.
