#### **Secretary – Sally Painter (absent)**

#### **Financial Analyst – Barb Hilty**

- General Fund Goal = \$57,540, Year to date = \$5,092.76
- Student Income Assessment Goal = \$35,848.75, Year to date = \$18,218.60

#### **Financial Secretary – Sandy Bauer**

- Sandy will finalize some outstanding fundraiser credit entries and distribute new account statements on approximately 10/26/09.
- Music lessons have been added to the Reimbursement Forms. Remember, assessments must be paid in full first before these deductions can be taken. These expenses should be paid up front to the instructor, and then a form should be submitted for reimbursement and will be paid on a monthly basis.

#### **Ways and Means – Colleen Blackham**

- Current fundraisers include Kidstuff Books due 10/26, fall fruit due 11/9, Pie Shop due 11/5, Sarris Candy due 10/28, Steeler Tickets due 11/2 and winter guard evergreens due 10/30.
- In September the general fund earned \$592.76.
- Tentative profit for Kiski Competition looks like approximately \$10,300, almost \$1,000 more than last year.
- Tentative profit for Car Cruise looks like approximately \$8,000. At November board meeting, board members will determine where to give a donation and what amount to give (probably local food banks, same as last year).
- Karen Hohman created a picture collage from the regional competition, which we will have reproduced and available for sale to anyone interested.

- Winter guard tryouts are to be held in November, with practices to begin in December.
- Kiski will host the winter guard championship competition on March 27th.
- Current on-going winter guard fundraisers are the evergreens and Sarris pretzels, with Rada Cutlery coming soon for delivery before Christmas. We are also planning to sell gourmet coffees and hot drinks in November, which is a new fundraiser.
