Financial Analyst – Barb Hilty

- General Fund Goal is \$57,540. General Fund YTD is \$26,645.19. General Fund due is \$30,894.81.
- Student Income Goal is \$35,848.75. Student Assessment YTD is \$20,803.16. Student income outstanding is \$15,045.59. 70 Students are paid in full.
- Taxes for last season are completed and filed.
