- General Fund Goal: \$57,540, General Fund YTD: \$41,315.02, General Fund Due: \$16,224.98
- Student Income Goal: \$35,728.75, Student Income YTD \$31,645.87, Student Income Outstanding \$4,082.88.

- There will be a combined May/June assessment mailed out in a few weeks.
- Currently in process of completing numbers from 2009/2010 season which ended May 31.
